News:

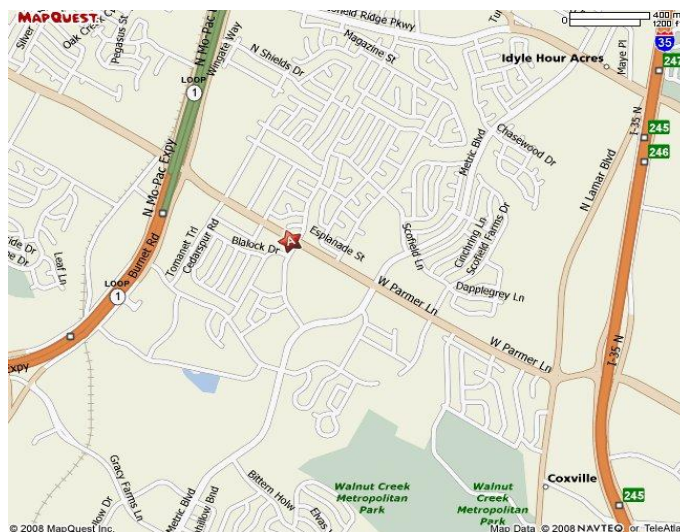

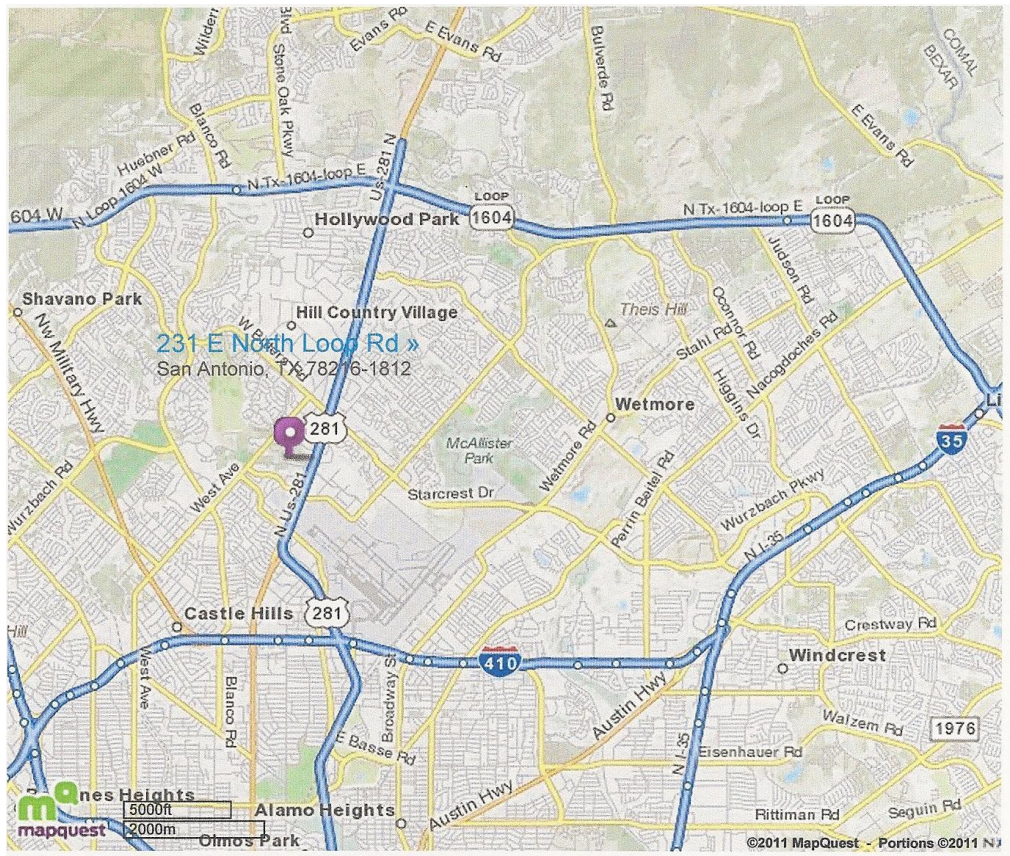

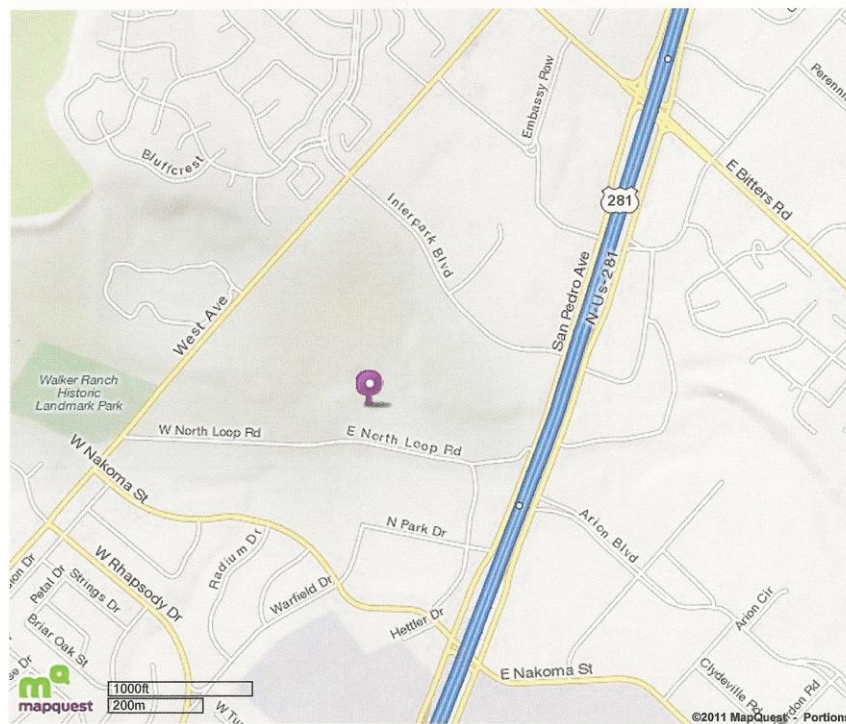
