News:

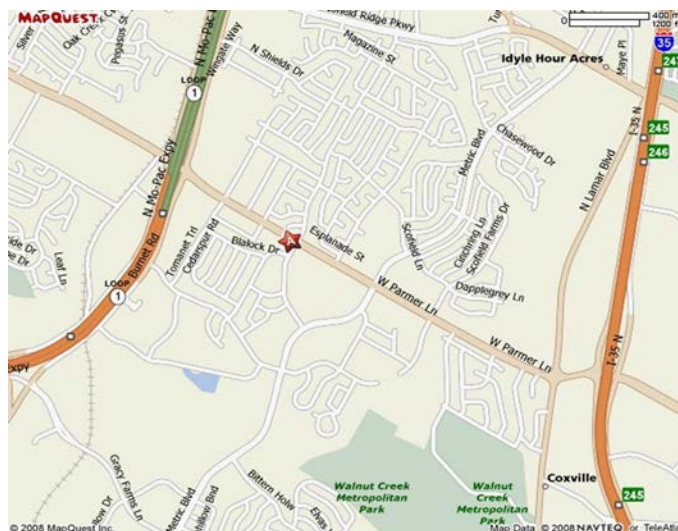
1. Dennis Warner will be representing the Guild at this years' AWCI Conference.
