Start looking for information regarding an upcoming case restoration class for watches.

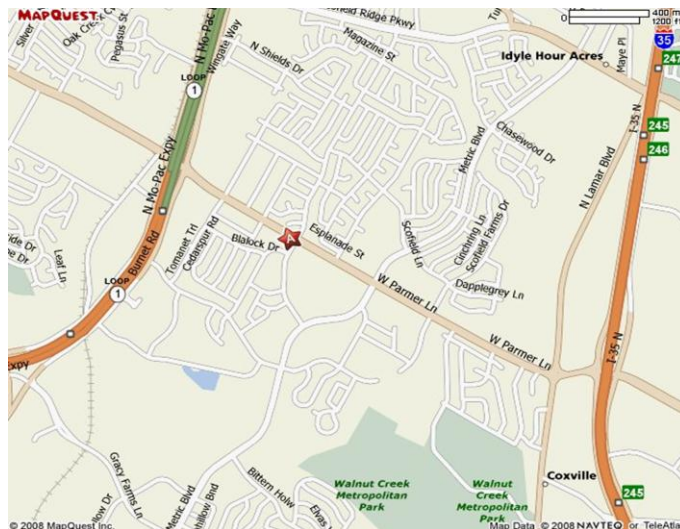
**News:**

1. There will be a Silent Auction prior to our **September** meeting. There is a flat \$5 fee to each seller.

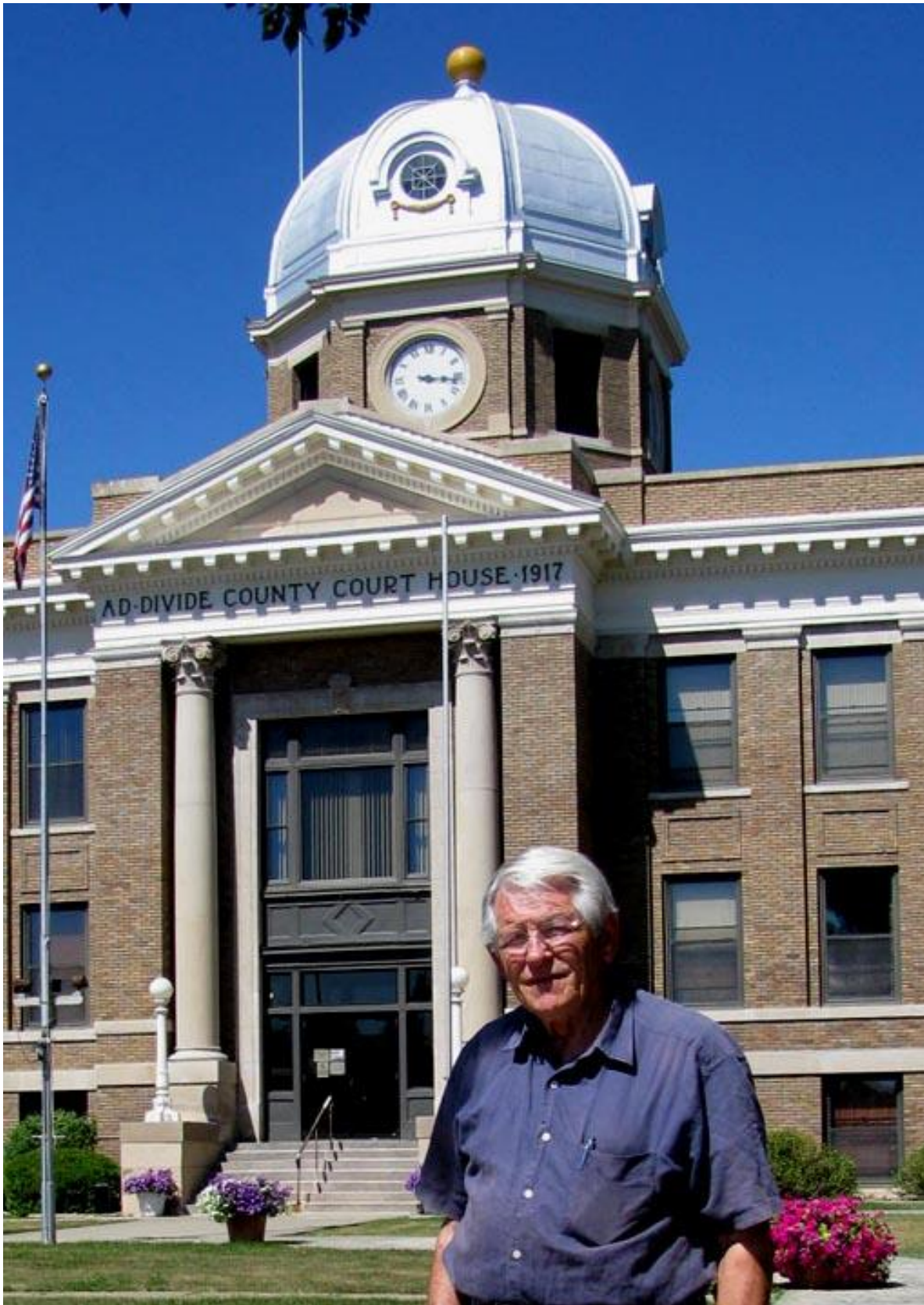
