Mary Ellen: No progress made on clock class, as Mary Ellen was out of the country.

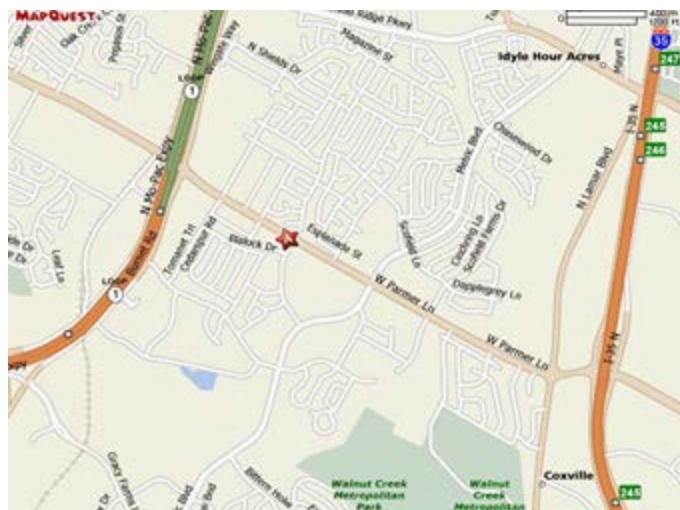

Directions:

From northbound Mopac:

Take the Steck Exit. Continue straight on the feeder road using the right lane to cross under Highway 183. Turn Right into Arbor Walk parking lot – Mimi's Café will be on your right.

From southbound Mopac:

Take the Capital of Texas Highway Exit (Loop 360). Turn left and make a U to cross over Mopac at the "T". Take the first Right into Arbor Walk parking lot. Turn right again to head to south end of the parking lot. Mimi's Café is at the south end of the parking lot.

From Highway 183:

Take the Capital of Texas Highway Exit (Loop 360). Head east on the Capital of Texas Highway. Cross over Mopac and turn left at the "T" and then take the next Right into Arbor Walk parking lot. Take another right to head to south end of the parking lot. Mimi's Café is at the south end of the parking lot.
